Nomination procedure by The home university	ENSAPLV accepts students selected by the home university in conformity with the number of students stipulated in the exchange agreement. Students are advised to study for a full academic year. Even if it is possible to arrive in the second semester, integration into the school is more difficult.

Upload all the required documents: Photo of the student Copy of passport Draft learning agreement signed by applicant and home university ٠ coordinator Certificate attesting French ability level at the moment of the application ٠ Confirmation signed by the home university coordinator A student's acceptance is not conditional on the provision of a portfolio, although it may be useful to the student on arrival at a course to introduce themselves to the teacher. We do not need the letter of intent and transcripts of records Do not send your application documents by post. The letter of acceptance will be sent to the home university in June for a first semester or a whole year study period and at the beginning of December for a second semester study period. CAUTION: Exchange students at ENSAPLV are not allowed to register as regular student of the school the year following their mobility. No applications can be made during their mobility. For example, a student in exchange during the academic year 2024/2025 will not be able to enrol as a regular student in 2025/2026 at ENSAPLV. At the end of the mobility period, student will have to continue to study at the home university and will only be able to apply for an admission for the academic year 2026/2027 at ENSAPLV. The study plan submitted in the application form is not final. This study plan will **STUDY PLAN AND PEDAGOGICAL** be definitively fixed after the pedagogical registration at the beginning of the RULES semester. However, it must comply with the pedagogical rules established ENSAPLV. 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LANGUAGE OF DIDACTICS	French is the teaching language. All theoretical courses are taught in French.
	A lot of teachers at ENSAPLV are from foreign countries. Depending on their language skills, some teachers are able to provide individual corrections in the student's language, particularly in Project courses.
RECOMMENDED LEVEL OF FRENCH LANGUAGE A minimum <u>B1 level in French abilities is strongly recommended</u> to be understand and attend classes.	
	Students who do not speak French will be limited in their choice of courses. They are advised to choose theory courses preferably in the second semester, after having improved their language skills in the first semester.
	<b><u>A French course</u></b> is offered during each semester (to be confirm) for the exchange students with a level below B2. This validation of the French course will allow 2 ECTS for the first semester and 1ECTS for the second semester.
INTERNSHIP Students who want to have a work experience through an internship is from their home university <u>a letter indicating that this internship is</u> during his/her studies to get their diploma. This letter is compulso agreement signed by ENSAPLV with the employer.	
	The internship must <u>take place during the mobility period</u> . Besides, the student must comply with ENSAPLV regulations internship (tutoring by ENSAPLV teacher, requirement of a written report). The student will then receive 8 ECTS credits.
