Upload all the required documents: Photo of the student Copy of passport Draft learning agreement signed by applicant and home university ٠ coordinator Certificate attesting French ability level at the moment of the application ٠ Confirmation signed by the home university coordinator A student's acceptance is not conditional on the provision of a portfolio, although it may be useful to the student on arrival at a course to introduce themselves to the teacher. We do not need the letter of intent and transcripts of records Do not send your application documents by post. The letter of acceptance will be sent to the home university at the end of May for a first semester or a whole year study period and at the beginning of December for a second semester study period. CAUTION: Exchange students at ENSAPLV are not allowed to register as regular student of the school the year following their mobility. No applications can be made during their mobility. For instance, an exchange student during 2023/2024 academic year will not be able to enrol as a regular student in 2024/2025. At the end of the mobility period, student will have to continue to study at the home university and will only be able to apply for an admission for 2025/2026 academic year. The study plan submitted in the application form is not final. This study plan will **STUDY PLAN AND PEDAGOGICAL** be definitively fixed after the pedagogical registration at the beginning of the RULES semester. However, it must comply with the pedagogical rules established ENSAPLV. 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LANGUAGE OF DIDACTICS	French is the teaching language. All theoretical courses are taught in French.
	A lot of teachers at ENSAPLV are from foreign countries. Depending on their language skills, some teachers are able to provide individual corrections in the student's language, particularly in Project courses.
RECOMMENDED LEVEL OF FRENCH LANGUAGE	A minimum <u>B1 level in French abilities is strongly recommended</u> to be able to understand and attend classes.
	Students who do not speak French will be limited in their choice of courses. They are advised to choose theory courses preferably in the second semester, after having improved their language skills in the first semester.
	<u>A French course</u> is offered during each semester (to be confirm) for the exchange students with a level below B2. This validation of the French course will allow 2 ECTS.
Internship	Students who want to have a work experience through an internship must bring from their home university <u>a letter indicating that this internship is compulsory</u> during his/her studies to get their diploma. This letter is compulsory to have an agreement signed by ENSAPLV with the employer.
	The internship must <u>take place during the mobility period</u> . Besides, the student must comply with ENSAPLV regulations internship (tutoring by ENSAPLV teacher, requirement of a written report). The student will then receive 8 ECTS credits.

HEALTH INSURANCE AND THIRD PERSON LIABILITY INSURANCE	Students from UE must bring their <u>European health insurance card</u> , valid till the end of their stay in France. Non-UE students have to register for <u>French health insurance</u> ("Sécurité sociale étudiant"). From 2018/2019 this is <u>free</u> of charge for students.
	Each student must have contracted a <u>third person liability insurance</u> . The student must bring a document giving evidence of this insurance.
Accomodation	ENSAPLV doesn't provide rooms in university residences ; the question of accommodation is very difficult in Paris and rather expensive ! (minimum $600 \in$ per month).
